

# 2018 Near Term Actions Report Card for the Executive Committee version 3.12.20

WESPER (LIO) members are working on many shore-term recovery projects, called Near Term Actions (NTAs). These projects contribute to the recovery of Puget Sound by focusing on threats to salmon habitat, shellfish health, and stormwater management. In 2018, WESPER recommended 44 NTAs that were adopted into the Puget Sound Action Agenda. To date, more than \$10.2 million has been secured from local, state, federal, and private funds for implementing of 20 of the 44 NTAs. Six NTAs are fully funded. The NTA Report Card below shows project status, total funds secured, and projects that need funding support.
