Background

WSPER has worked over the last two years to integrate the functions of the Lead Entity salmon recovery body and Local Integrating Organization ecosystem recovery body into one organization. One of the final steps is for WSPER to develop new mission and vision statements that reflect WSPER's combined ecosystem and salmon recovery focus.

In fall 2020, the WSPER Working Group reviewed the old mission and vision statements for both the Lead Entity and LIO prior to their merger and recommended a new mission and vision for WSPER that reflect the organization's combined focus and current work.

Recommended Vision:

WSPER's vision for West Sound is healthy and resilient ecosystems, thriving salmon runs, and vibrant communities.

Recommended Mission:

WSPER's mission is to support the implementation of science-based, community-supported ecosystem restoration and protection efforts in the West Sound.
