

WESPER members and partners are working on many short-term recovery projects, called Near Term Actions (NTAs). These projects contribute to Puget Sound ecosystem recovery with specific focus in habitat, shellfish health, and stormwater management. In 2018, WSPER recommended 45 NTAs that were adopted into the 2018-2022 Puget Sound Action Agenda. To date, about \$16.8 million has been secured from local, state, federal, and private funds to implement 25 of the 45 NTAs. The NTA Report Card below shows the project status, total funds secured, and projects that continue to need funding support.
